Good evening, The weather let up so I went to St. Peters Cemetery on Saturday with no luck finding any sites the office was closed so I decided to go back this morning (Monday). This is what I was told. Howard Eccles - Old area during the time that they did single burials. Very few old headstones. This area has a hill area and a valley area. In the old days they buried according to the weather. If it was raining they buried at the top of the hill if not the bottom of the hill in the valley. He is listed at the top of the hill but no stone. This area has been re-fielded. By this they mean that they added about 10 feet of topsoil added a couple of retaining walls and have reburials there

I did find some old stones but not his. Georgia Farley- Good and bad luck. She is buried in the lot owned by Fred Walke. Unfortunately, no stones or markings on the lot.
